#### **MANRS IS MATURING**

In developing MANRS, we —as a community— have always strived for transparency, inclusion, and consensus: working groups, task forces, community last calls.

To expand the initiative's impact further, we need a formal process to guide how MANRS documents —either normative (MANRS Actions) or informational (MANRS Implementation Guides)— are developed, adopted, and maintained.

The objectives are clear:

 Increase credibility, transparency and inclusiveness: a formal, documented mechanisms to develop and modify MANRS documentation (MANRS Actions, MANRS Charter...)

• Introduce a formal document series: this provides stable references and version control, making it easier to refer to it in external documents

# **RATIFICATION AND PUBLICATION OF A STANDARD**





#### MANRS DOCUMENT SERIES: NAMING AND VERSION CONTROL

- Naming convention: drafts
  - YYYYMM-DRAFT-(subject).zz => The initial version is '01'
  - Example: 202511-DRAFT-netops-actions.01

#### • Naming convention: approved specifications

- MANRS-xxx.yy => The initial version of an approved specification is '01'
- Example: MANRS-003.01



#### **SPECIAL CASES**

#### • MDP without the formation of a working group (MDP-lite)

 The proposal or the proposed changes to the existing standards are well understood and formed, so there is no need for a working group
Announcement > Call for Comments

#### Amendment of the MDP itself

• Should use MDP or MDP-lite

• Handling of technical and editorial errata

• Errata reported and published (cf: '<u>IESG Processing of RFC Errata for the IETF Stream</u>')

• Is the specification corrected?



Proposal submitted to the Secretariat	January 27
Proposal submitted to the Steering Committee (SC)	January 27
Proposal announced by the SC	January 29
The SC opens a four-week call for comments	January 30 – February 28
Incorporation of feedback	March 3 – March 7
MANRS Last Call open by the SC	March 10 – March 24
Ratification of the MDP by the SC	March 24 – April 4
Publication of the MDP	April 8
